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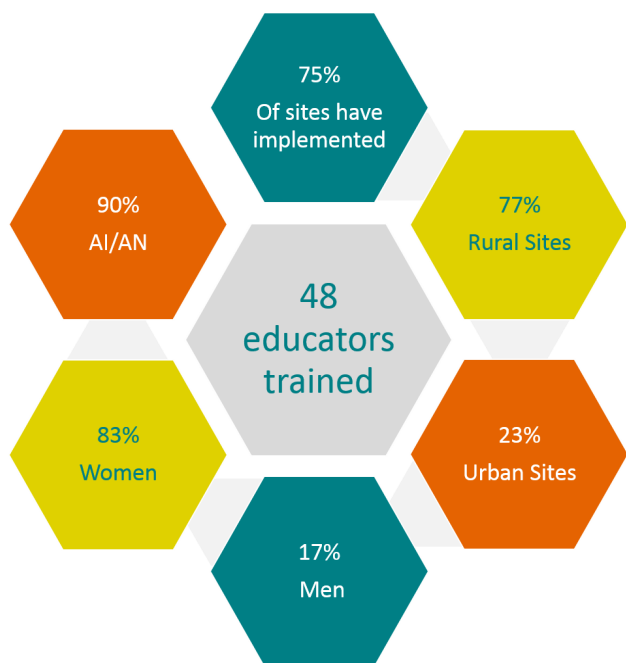

The Native STAND project is committed to building the capacities of tribal communities to engage in research.

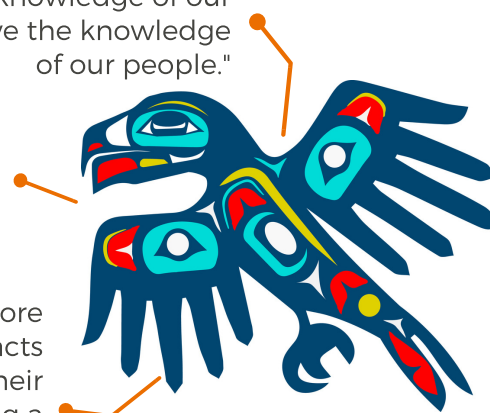


## WORDS FROM THE FIELD

### Curriculum:

Addresses STDs, HIV, healthy relationships, teen pregnancy, & positive decision-making skills

### Peer Education:

Empower tribal youth to communicate accurate information on sexual health to other teens

### Program Evaluation:

Based on the RE-AIM (Reach, Effectiveness, Adoption, Implementation, & Maintenance) framework

Healthy Native Youth: A one-stop shop for educators promoting adolescent health & wellbeing

# 49%

Of AI/AN teen participants from 36 sites were boys and girls aged 14 to 15 years.

# 75%

Of girls indicated they were "definitely sure" they could use a condom correctly after taking Native STAND.

Healthy Native Youth web views in 2017 with reach in 50 states and 57 countries.
